A lengthy discussion was held on how to attract new hams to the hobby and ultimately new club members. What has not worked in the pass is direct mail (post cards) and community activities such as the Seaboard Festival. No new ideas were suggested or recommended at this time.

A Spring picnic was discussed. Food was left over from the 3970 Group picnic that could be utilized for the feed. No suggested date at this time.

Additional discussions were held on ECOM activities (ARES/RACES). ARRL has online courses available as does FEMA for those interested in pursuing the subject.

Due to the date of the Charlotte Hamfest, our March meeting will be moved to the 3rd Saturday (3/21).
